DBS CHECK STATUS

INSTRUCTOR GRADE REQUIREMENTS

Revolution Martial Arts Academy always ensures that instructors are qualified to or above the minimum standard expected by our association. This is a Black Belt.

FIRST AID STATUS

Revolution Martial Arts Academy takes the safety of its members seriously. All instructor are first aid trained to an acceptable standard and sufficient emergency first aid equipment is present at all classes and on site at all times. A risk assessment and associated health and safety briefs are conducted prior to classes commencing.

PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP

Revolution Martial Arts Academy takes its responsibilities to run a professional class seriously. Accordingly, we are registered with BMABA. FEES & CHARGES

Revolution Martial Arts Academy does not have any hidden costs or dishonest fee collections in place. All money is payable by cash/cheque/direct debit/paypal etc when due, and receipts will be issued. Our club charges £45 registration fee to include association membership, insurance, belts etc and this is payable after 1 session of training with us. This fee is payable only once a year.

Classes are charged at variable rates depending on the class type, however our standard class fee is £22 per one class, £44 per two classes and £56 for full time members . Please check any rates or charges before committing to training encase this has changed.

You are NOT bound by any contract and may discontinue training at any time.
